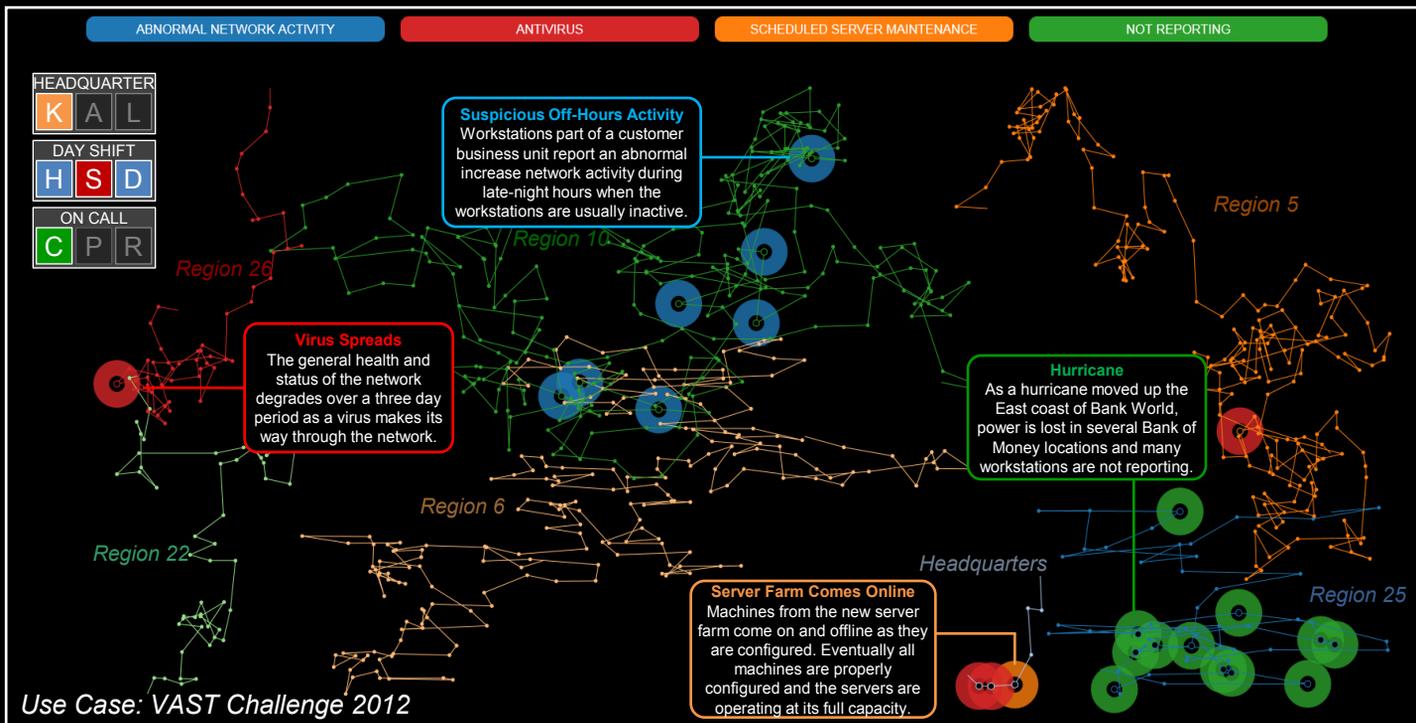


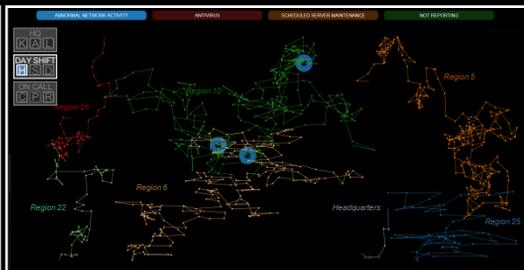

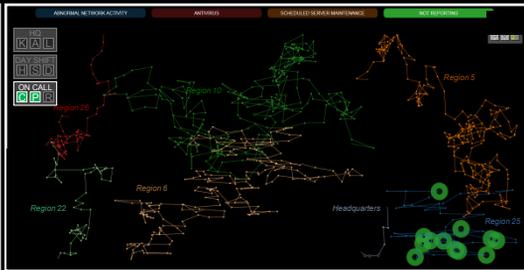
Selecting **Abnormal Network Activity** allows you to see everywhere that type of event is occurring. Then, by selecting Hank from Day Shift, you can see which of the abnormal network activity events he is investigating.



Selecting **AntiVirus** shows everywhere AV signatures are hitting on the network, including the Headquarters network. By selecting the Headquarters network, you can see that Kenny from Headquarters is working the **Scheduled Server Maintenance** – of which may be affected by the virus outbreak.



Selecting **Not Reporting** shows that Celeste from the On Call team is the only admin assigned the **Region 25** outage due to the Hurricane and may need assistance once power is restored.
